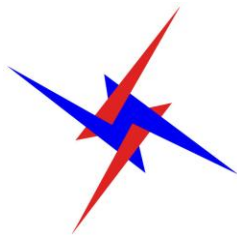

The Extraordinary God

People have identified gods of all sorts throughout history. Generally the purpose of identifying things and ideas as gods has been to explain unknown and non-comprehensible things that affect people's lives. From the greatest to the simplest intellects, people have used the word "god" to describe what they did not understand.

People have believed god's to be multiple, limited, and inconsistent with each other in many cultures. Such things as weather, astronomical entities, and earth movement were feared and worshipped with valuable sacrifices in efforts to contemplate their roll in human life. Two things that people have always been convinced of are: 1. forces of existence are greater than people's ultimate capability to control, and 2. all forces of existence affect every aspect of human life. It doesn't take a scientist to realize the deficiency we mortal humans have in our lives and the ultimately uncontrollable effects deficiencies have on our lives.

It has only been in recent years that science has gained the knowledge that all forces and things, right down to the least detectable elements, are interrelated. God miraculously chooses to limit Himself for our sake, but He is ultimately limitless and infinitely worthy of recognition unlike anything mortal human beings can define.

The Incomprehensible God

Trinity is "not" the primary focus of reconciliation. Many who doubt reconciliation seem to portray beliefs in a Triune God as the primary focus as well as a stumbling block to believing. Some use trinity as a limiting factor to discredit others' faith. But whether anyone believes in trinity or not has no bearing on reconciliation.

The primary purpose of the Trinity is a comprehension issue. Every conceivable way humans can think of describing God does not come close to the all inclusiveness of God. Every possible comprehension people have of God, no matter how unbridled, still holds God inside a box of human understanding. The truth be known, God is limitless and unbridled.

No matter what version of any sort of faith, God is identified and described by them all. Whether Christian, Jew, Muslim, or any other; none have a corner on the God-market. God can not, and never will be, all-inclusively described even by the historical sum of all human beings. Even the Christian Bible only uses Trinity as one form of describing God but recognizes that it is nowhere near complete.

So how can we know God? How can people gain any kind of comprehension of, and relation to, an unlimited God? The number one fact to remember is that God would not be our God if God was not unlimited to us. Anyone who believes they have a greater grasp on God than another is fooling themselves. Trying to describe and identify with God without sharing God's endlessness is a contradiction of astronomical proportions.

Trinity has been capitalized on by multitudes of people because it is a very comprehensible way to have a type of understanding of God. It is comparably easy to grasp a Triune God in our three dimensional existence. People who understand ourselves to have a body, soul, and spirit tend to find it fairly easy to comprehend a Triune God of similar elements. Many, who do not tend to grasp understanding of people as body, soul, and spirit, generally do not relate well to a Triune God. Likewise, it is a struggle for many to fathom how multitudes of elements and levels exist in humans similar to the multiple levels of God's existence.

This brings us to the third mortal evidence of God; no matter can be measured in its most basic form. This is evidence of central source design and assembly by a higher level of designer than humanity is capable of physically detecting.

Physical evidence points toward mortal lack of availability to measure and define the "ultimate" design, weight, size, and energy of anything in existence. Therefore, the central source and focus and all that exists would be no place other than exactly where God would be expected to be; outside of time and space. Anything less than a God who is the source and focus of existence would be mortally detectable, less than the sum of everything that exists, and as limited and comprehensible as anything else that people have called "god".

If God is the central source and focus of existence then that entity would be involved with all that exists. Not only would being the source of existence constitute God's creation and design of all that exists; God would: be the central source of life; be able to see the end of time before it began, and; have established a way for existence to be always eternal (as such a God would have to be eternal). As the creator of intellect, emotions, and will, God would transcend them and design human abilities to choose and reject God and God would choose to retain those who choose God. The Most Unique God

Isn't it peculiar that the Bible describes people with "unusual" type words but never describes God as unusual?

The word unique has a variety of meanings and many of them are used to describe God in the Bible. However, none of them seem to point out that God is unique.

"I Am that I Am" is the most direct description God gives of the central personality of existence. How else could a totally unique being be described?

Exodus 3:14 And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.

Throughout the Bible God has many descriptions preceded by "I AM". It's almost as if the word unique has been avoided in order to present whatever point was being made at the time

Even inspiration directly from the ultimate source of the conception of existence could not bring about words to describe all that God is.
